CHANGE

Almost everyone fears the unknown. That is one reason people don't like change. They are consumed with anxiety and stress when change is on the horizon. Change is scary and disruptive. I remember my father writing a course for his management training called "Managing Change". It helped managers navigate the fear of the employees. Jesus tells His disciples, let not your hearts be troubled (John 14:27) because change was coming.

When Mary was told she would bear a child while still a virgin, the angel Gabriel tells her not to be afraid (Luke 1:30). He tells Joseph the same thing (Matthew 1:20). What change and unknown territory it was for a young teenage girl being told she would bear God's own Son.

As we approach fall and the impending change of fall colors, I am reminded of an episode of "Little House on the Prairie" where a snow blizzard required them to tie a rope on the front porch. When they would tend to the animals, they could use the rope to find their way back to safety. They were anchored, so to speak, to the safety of the house.

We don't have to fear the storms of life, nor worry about change that is encroaching upon us because God is our anchor (Hebrews 6:19). Malachi 3:6 reads: "For I am the Lord, I do not change". This should provide the comfort that Jesus told His disciples in John 14:27.

God is the same today as He was in the Past and is the same as He will be in the Future (Hebrews 13:8). We can count on God. We don't have to be stressed because He has always wanted obedience in exchange for His Grace. In the Old Testament, Samuel stated, "Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15:22). This is echoed in the New Testament in 2 Thessalonians 1:8. Obedience has never changed in God's plan to redeem man.

Under the New Testament, obedience requires responding to God's word by believing (Mark 16:15-16), repenting (Luke 13:3), being baptized for remission of sins (Acts 2:38), and living faithfully unto death (Revelation 2:10).

Being a Christian is the least stressful thing you can do. You can find hope in a God that does not change.
