THANKFULNESS

We all know we ought to be thankful every day, not just the fourth Thursday of November. Nevertheless, as with New Years resolutions, it's entirely too easy to forget to give God the thanks we owe Him for the countless blessings we enjoy by His grace.

Long ages ago most Gentiles turned their backs on God. *"Although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, **nor were thankful**, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened"* (Romans 1:21). Failure to be thankful constitutes only one of the numerous qualities characteristic of people who don't know God.

As Paul languished in a Roman dungeon awaiting execution he warned his son in the faith, Timothy, about *"perilous times"* that the young preacher would soon face. *"Men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, **unthankful**, unholy . . ."* (2 Timothy 3:2). The list goes on at length, but you get the drift. Unthankfulness keeps some quite unsavory company!

Christians, of all people, ought to be characterized by thankfulness. We have even more reason than the psalmist to exclaim, *"what shall I render to the Lord for all His benefits toward me?"* (Psalm 116:12). Gratitude isn't a debt that can be paid, but we certainly can and should express our thanks and praise.
