# ACT LIKE MEN

Paul instructs the men to stand firm in the faith, be watchful, strong, and ACT LIKE MEN (1 Corinthians 16:13-14). He immediately follows up with let it be done in love. There are too many people who do not accept their God-given roles. When a player starts to officiate the game, he is quickly eliminated from the game, or chaos ensues. God has given us all roles that are different, not less important, but different.

A few chapters earlier, Paul addresses men and women submitting to one another. Submission is not a bad word. Simply Philippians 2:3-4 tells us we ought to put other people's needs before our own. Submission is a choice you make before you make your vows to your spouse. You are agreeing to submit to one another. This is different for men and women. Men are to be the head of the house (1 Corinthians 11:3, 9). Women are to look after the affairs of the household based on biblical principles as a helpmate (Genesis 2:18) to the head of the household (Proverbs 31:47).

What does submitting look like for the husband? He is to sacrifice for the family (Galatians 5:25-31). Often, the husband will be the last to get new shoes, for instance. He is the provider for the family. He will see that the needs of the wife are taken care of. Those needs are security and safety, both physically and emotionally. In short, a wife wants to be loved.

A wife is to respect her husband (Ephesians 5:33). This involves trust that the husband is doing what he feels is in the best interests of the family. When you say "I DO", you give up the right to complete independence and doing what you want for YOU. God destroyed the earth because man did what was in HIS best interest and was evil continuously (Genesis 6:5). Part of respecting a husband is trusting him. As long as he is not doing anything immoral or illegal, submit to one another.

Jesus said a house divided will fall (Matthew 12:25). There is ONLY one head of the house. Men should communicate and provide a safe environment for their family, but when there is an impasse (again, not moral or illegal), the wife needs to submit to the husband. Submission is not a bad thing. Jesus submitted to the Father (John 6:38) yet was considered equal to the Father (John 10:30). They simply had different roles.

A last note to husbands. Jesus warns us, as heads, not to LORD over our wives. WE are not to treat them as second-class citizens. He compared those to the Gentiles (Matthew 20:25). Communicating, respecting, and compromising are part of every relationship. A marriage is not 50/50. It is 100/100. Don't have the attitude that I will love her when she respects me. Do your part! Submit to one another (Ephesians 5:21).
