# DREW

The Old Testament mentions the term dew thirty-six times. It represents God's blessing and mercy. Often God's people were found in desert settings. They depended on the dew for survival.

Manna settled upon the dew when the Israelites left Egypt (Genesis 27, Numbers 11, Exodus 16). It was used to produce fruits and vegetables as they needed water to grow crops (Haggai 1:10, Zechariah 8:12).

The Bible often uses dew in spiritual contexts. It describes speech settling on people like dew (Job 29:22). The song of Moses petitions that his speech be distilled like dew (Deuteronomy 32:2), meaning it removes the impurities and presents the pure words of God.

Furthermore, dew is described as the favor of the king (Proverbs 19:12) and a precious gift from heaven (Deuteronomy 33:13). We can go on, but you get the point. It represents the providence of God. Our lives depend upon the precious, pure gift of God's Grace.

We, in turn, should not overlook the simple daily blessings given to us from God (Zechariah 4:10). "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18).

Think about it. Dew is less obvious than rain. Rabbi Ruth Gias said, "To be aware of the dew is to become alert to all of the hidden goodness of God that we so often take for granted."

Providence often goes unnoticed. We forget to thank God for the little things in life; however, God continues to bless us continually.

If we are not careful, we may end up with a drought and no dew except God's word (Judges 6:37). We are to be obedient to the Gospel and remain faithful (2 Thessalonians 1:8). How sad it will be if we do not appreciate the little blessings and we may eventually beg for just a drop of water to quench our thirst (Luke 16:24).

I want to remind you to recognize and thank God for the little blessings He bestows upon us daily. If you only focus on the storms of life, you are missing out on the great lessons God intended us to learn from the little things.
